1. Nomination

Important: Learning Agreement

The selection of the subjects must be done together with the academic coordinator of your university and ours. The Direction of Internationalization and Mobility will put you in contact with the person in charge. Once you have presented all the documentation and a signed learning agreement, we will send you, by e-mail, the Certificate of Acceptance.



2.2.- Attachments:

- Academic qualifications/transcript of records
- Passport or ID card copy.
- 1 (one) Photo 4x4
- Recommendation letter of your home university
- Medical Certificate (physical and psychological health state)
- International Health Insurance card copy.
- Certificate of Criminal Record copy with the Apostille from the country of origin (Important: necessary to process the Student Visa¹)



¹VISA Requirements

- *If you do not need a VISA to enter Argentina, you can come as a tourist (tourist status) and then at the Migrations Office, here in Salta, you apply for the Student Visa – within the 30 days that University informs you of your registration*
- *Remember to bring your Criminal Record Certificate with the Apostille from your country of origin. It will be requested by the Migrations Office.*

- *If the international student needs more information about the Student Visa, the Internationalization and Mobility Office will send it by request. Orientation will be provided at all time.*

3. Buddy Program

If the international student needs help with the integration and adaptation process or general assistance, a local student can be assigned by request.

4. Application Deadline(s)

For annual mobility: November 15th.

For the first semester (*March-July*): November 15 th.

For the second semester (*August - December*): May 15 th.
